

CAREER MAPS AND PATHS PROJECT UPDATE

Workplace interviews

Projects International has continued to complete workplace interviews, where they match the data gathered on job roles, with what exists in the workplace. Workplaces visited around Wellington included restaurants, coffee bars, information centres, hotels, travel agencies, museums, art galleries and the airport. Visits will continue over the coming weeks in Auckland and Rotorua, with visits to Christchurch and Queenstown in the planning stage.

This work has proved very useful in helping to refine the career pathway process.

Database

Following a period of intense work with Digital fusion, a prototype database is now going through a trial period. This work has proven most beneficial in clarifying the thinking around sectors and workplaces. This has resulted in a reclassification of both the allocation of jobs to workplaces, and workplaces to sectors. The simplification will make it much easier to retrieve data from the database and will make using the database tool a much more intuitive exercise for users.

Job Role Salaries

Determining job role salaries has been a recent focus. A number of discussions have been held with the Department of Labour to clarify what salaries, education levels and employment options exist across the two ITO sectors, with a very large amount of information supplied.
