#### For 2008 / 2009 students:

#### For 2009 / 2010 students there are two options:

2009	Year 12	Students start the National Certificate in Tourism and Travel (Introductory Skills) (Level 2) [Ref: 0875] version 2 - Compulsory unit standards 18230, 18232 must be delivered this year as they are expiring 31 Dec 2009 - If unit standard 18224 in Elective 2 is part of your programme you must deliver it this year as it expires 31 Dec 2009 (or) Students start the NEW National Certificate in Tourism (Introductory Skills) [Ref: 0875] version 3
2010	Year 13	Students who started version 2 would finish version 2 (or) Students who started the NEW qualification would finish the NEW qualification
